Memorandum of Understanding on Educational and Academic Exchange and
Research Collaboration
Between

Mahidol University
And
United International University

Mahidol University (henceforth MU) and United International University (henceforth UIU) with the aim to consummate this Memorandum of Understanding, represented by their respective faculty members of Research Institute for Languages and Culture of Asia and English Language Institute enter into the following terms of agreement for advancing educational and academic exchange and research collaboration between the two educational institutions.

Article 1: MU and UIU agree to cooperate on expanding opportunities for the education of the students, provision of international teaching exposure for the faculty members and facilitation of academic research among the faculty members and researchers.

Article 2: In order to promote cooperation mentioned in Article 1, both institutions may carry out the undertakings as described in the following, and the detailed endeavours of the collaboration shall be specified and agreed upon in writing by further discourse between the two institutions.

(a) Exchange of faculty members, researchers, and students;

In terms of exchange of faculty members, upon the requisition from the counterpart (not home institution), faculty members (as visiting academic faculty) from any disciplines will be able to carry out their academic responsibility for one (1) or two (2) semesters. Regarding exchange of students, students (as exchange students) from any disciplines will be able to pursue their study (incorporating mobility programs) in their counterpart (host institution) for one (1) or two (2) semesters.

(b) Cooperation in conducting research and the presentation of the obtained research results;

In terms of research project sharing, faculty members and researchers of both institutions will collaborate among them as Principal Investigator (PI) or Co-Investigator(s).

(c) Exchange of academic information and publications

(d) Development of dual and double degree programmes for undergraduate and graduate students

(e) Other activities mutually agreed upon between the two parties

The respective Heads/Directors of both institutions will play crucial role in dealing or negotiating with potential activities that might spring up in the future.

Article 3: Detailed management of intellectual property rights and publication shall be defined in a separate written agreement for each activity agreed in Article 2.

Article 4: Financial Agreement

The financial agreements for each activity agreed in Article 2 shall be negotiated and agreed upon by both parties in writing.

Article 5: Different viewpoints and interpretations of this MOU shall be settled amicably by mutual consultation or negotiation.

Article 6: Amendments to this MOU may be made upon mutual written agreement between the two institutions.

Article 7: This MOU may be terminated by either party after one year, tendering written notice to the other party.

Article 8: This MOU shall come into force on the day it will be signed by both parties; in addition, this MOU will come into effect on and from the date of execution of this agreement and will continue to be effective for a period of five (5) years and may be extended for such further period as may be agreed by both parties in writing.

Article 9: In case, any situation arises that the activities under Article 2 continue after the termination of this MOU, both institutions will cooperate with each other in good faith in accordance with such sprung activities until those activities come to an end.

Article 10: This MOU is made in English as the mutually agreed official language. Two (2) copies of this MOU are made and signed in original by both institutions. In addition, this MOU comprises three (3) pages, including mentioned 11 articles and a page for signature.

Article 11: Every notice, request, or any other communication required or permitted to be given pursuant to this MOU shall be in writing, in English and delivered personally or sent by registered or certified post via air mail or by courier or facsimile (which will be acknowledged by the other party) to the parties at the following address and facsimile number.
