Conditions:

The following criteria will be followed in the sanctioning of 100% Tuition Fee and Other Fees Waiver for Meritorious and Poor Students from Underdeveloped Regions Quota:

- i. 3% (three percent) of the newly admitted students of Fall 2024 trimester, who qualify under this category, are eligible to apply in this category.
- ii. The waiver is being offered for both undergraduate and graduate students.
- iii. The applicant must have his/her permanent address in one of the upazilas listed under the category of 'Very High Level of Poverty' in the Bangladesh Bureau of Statistics (BBS) Report.
- iv. The applicant must have passed HSC examination from an educational institution located in the upazila/district of his/her permanent address.
- v. A student, who receives this waiver, will be waived from tuition fee and other fees except admission fee, ID caution fee and retake course(s) fees.
- vi. Upon selection, s/he will continue to receive the waiver till they obtain their degree, subject to the condition that s/he would be required to obtain a minimum GPA of 3.00 in a particular trimester for becoming eligible to get 100% Tuition Fee and Other Fees Waiver in the following trimester.
- vii. Applicants, who are eligible for both the categories of 100% Tuition Fee and Other Fees Waiver for Meritorious and Poor Students from Underdeveloped Regions and 100% Scholarship in order of Merit, will be awarded the waiver from the category of 100% Tuition Fee and Other Fees Waiver for Meritorious and Poor Students from Underdeveloped Regions.
- viii. Undergraduate students of BSCSE, BSEEE, BSDS, BBA, BBA in AIS, BSECO have to register minimum 9 credits and graduate students of MBA, EMBA, MSECO, MDS, MSCSE have to register minimum 6 credits in each trimester.
